Arrive at Penn State Arboretum, you will have a guided tour of the H.O. Smith Botanic Gardens with a focus on the new Children's garden. Take some time to explore on your own after our tour before a quick stop at the famous Berkey Creamery. We'll have box lunches to enjoy en route to Pittsburgh. Take a tour at the National Aviary where you will encounter exotic, rare, and endangered birds up close as you are transported from rocky coastlines through a tropical rainforest to serene grasslands. Free-flight, walk-through exhibits allow birds to perch at arm's length and greet you, while more elusive inhabitants are only discovered by careful study of the tree tops and groundcover. Live feedings and encounters will have birds eating from your hands and provide an intimate and informative look at their most interesting natural behaviors. Check into the Doubletree by Hilton. Dinner is included at the hotel tonight.

Friday, October 16, 2015

Begin the day at the brand new Pittsburgh Botanic Garden, with a 90 minute docent led tour and some free time, next stop is the beautiful Station square, full of shops and restaurants where you can grab a bite for lunch before we board the Gateway Clipper for a sightseeing cruise on the Three Rivers. After your cruise we'll head over to the famous Duquesne Incline, you will see the view from above on this fantastic century old cable car as you travel up Mt Washington. Once you arrive, take a few minutes to explore the historical displays at the top then walk a block over to the famous Lemont's Restaurant for your early dinner in the lap of luxury. Your view will include the twinkling lights of Pittsburgh as the sun goes down. After dinner you have an evening tour at Phipps Conservatory.



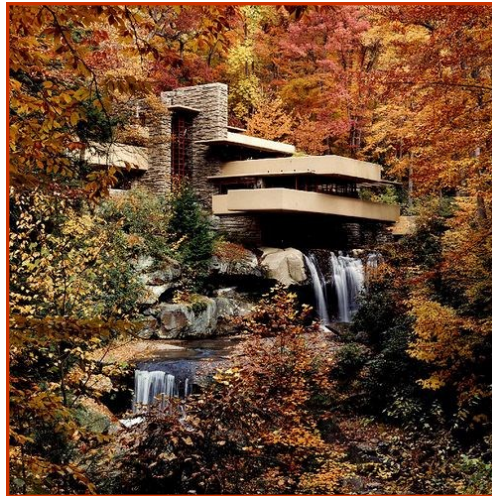
